The text must be written in English. Please use Times New Roman 12 pt. as font and single line spacing for the abstract and entire text. There should be a top margin of 2.5 cm and a bottom, left and right margin of 2 cm. Title of the text should be in CAPITAL BOLD LETTERS with a font size of 14 pt., with a maximum length of two lines. The name of the authors should be written in bold letters, with a font size of 12 pt. and the name of the presenting author should be underlined. Institution names (Affiliations) should be in italic letters with a font size of 10 pt. Please add the e-mail information of the presenting and corresponding authors in brackets. Leave 2 blank lines with font size of 12 pt. before the body text. The body text should be written with a font size of Arial 12 pt. It is the author's responsibility to submit correct text (spelling, grammar, scientific facts, accuracy and layouts).

The abstracts and the text are evaluated by the Scientific Committee and the Conference Chair.

Note: All parts of the manuscript should be typewritten, single line spacing, Times New Roman 12 pt.

Number manuscript pages consecutively throughout the paper.

The entire original manuscripts should not exceed 8 pages in length.
